#### **Faculty Development Programme**

FDP was organized for the NHC faculty at the New Horizon campus in Kasturinagar. It was conducted over three days (17<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> January 2019 from 9.30A.M -12.30 P.M) covering aspects of teaching, learning, mentoring and lesson plan.

# Day 1: Resource Faculty: Dr. Girija Srinivasalu Head- QASDC (Quality Assurance & Skill Development Centre) New Horizon College of Education

The session covered topics on

- 1. Planning
- 2. Lesson presentation and instructional skills
- 3 .Classroom organization and Management
- 4. Positive classroom mindset
- 5. Evaluation of students
- 6. Interpersonal relations and communication
- 7. Professionalism
- 8. Other contributions

The teachers were grouped on the basis of the subjects and made to do a sample lesson plan taking into consideration the number of working days and total number of periods assigned.

This was a very informative session and everyone was made aware of the importance of doing the lesson plan with seriousness and diligence.

### Day 2: Mr. Shanthakumar Sr. Asst. Prof--New Horizon College of Education.

"Every learner should be the constructor of knowledge". The session commenced with this inspiring quote.

This session dealt with the skills needed for teaching and learning. The resource faculty used analogies from statistics (mean, mode, median) to explain the methodology and techniques.

Based on the class the following points were to be kept in mind:

- 1. Understand the intellectual abilities of each of the student in the class.
- 2. The structure of the subject.
- 3. Methodology or techniques of teaching.

- 4. Facts, concepts formulae, principles, laws and generalizations, phenomenon, process, history and skill of illustration.
- 5. Devices used to facilitate teaching: artificial, natural and fixing devices.

Factors influencing learning:

- 1. Maturation.
- 2. Motivation.
- 3. Attention.
- 4. Retention.

He reiterated the importance of testing the class of previously done unit or chapter. This would act as a scale to measure and evaluate a student's progress and understanding.

Day 3: Resource Faculty: Resource Faculty: Dr. Girija Srinivasalu Head-QASDC (Quality Assurance & Skill Development Centre) New Horizon College of Education

Topic covered was Mentoring. She began with the quote, "I will help you be whoever you want to be"

Interacting with the faculty, she evoked responses on student behavior and through anecdotes brought about a realization that the teacher is the only one responsible to make or mar a classroom experience. She discouraged the idea of blaming students for bad conduct and disinterest.

Acquiring life skills was important to a teacher which will help to assess a student based on

- 1. Communication
- 2. Social and economic background
- Psychological.
- 4. Health.
- 5. Technical.
- 6. Managerial.

In totality, the faculty development programme was informative and taught us skills that we thus far had neglected thinking it was meant only for the school going children.
