Student Club is a form of governance run by the students to contribute towards growth of the student community and the growth of the institution.



The purpose of the committee is to see to it that the objectives of this union are carried out effectively, by enacting legislation, by supervising, coordinating and financing the execution of a broad array of academic, co-curricular and extracurricular activities.

Objectives of the Student Club :

- To promote the interests of students among the administration, staff and parents.
- To inform students about any subject that concerns them.
- To consult students on any issue of importance.
- To organise educational and recreational activities for students.
- To propose activities to the administration that would improve the quality of life in an institution.
- To maintain good relations with the Student Club Staff (the principal, teaching and non teaching personnel) and parents.
- To promote self growth.

Activities of the Student Club :

- To organise and coordinate various activities and meetings throughout the year.
- To communicate its opinion to the class mentors on any subject that concerns students which the council wishes to be consulted on.
- To assist the teachers in organising the various calendar of events and put the plans into action.
- To promote and encourage the involvement of students in organising and participation of activities and events.

- 2. Social Opportunities:** Many clubs and organizations are formed based on leisure and recreational interest. Students may wish to pursue membership in these types of clubs for personal enjoyment and also use this as an opportunity to meet people with the same interest.
- 3. Professional Experience:** The student club encourages career development and an understanding of opportunities within the industry. Students can access information about internships and job opportunities by becoming active in professional organizations.
- 4. Personal Development:** Joining the student clubs gives the opportunity to meet a diverse population that allows one to expand one's thinking and interest. It encourages personal development through communication and exploration of different interests.
- 5. Leadership Skills:** Joining a club allows students to develop leadership skills within the peer group. Students will be able to learn from fellow students and establish leadership abilities through planning and implementing different co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.
- 6. Organization and Management Skills:** Students gain valuable experience in the execution of procedures and policies by their involvement in clubs. These systems help students to understand the organizational structure and help the students to build the relevant skills.
- 7. Building College Culture :** Various clubs enable the students to unleash their talents and meet people who share similar interests which creates a strong sense of belonging and attachment to the college which results in establishing college culture.

- To advertise and promote any upcoming events and activities to their respective classes.
- To bridge the gap between the management and the students with regard to communication.
- To attend and actively participate in all proceedings of the student club.
- To take up the role of each cell/committee assigned to them and conduct the activities by consulting the respective faculty incharge.

Club-heads and Sub-heads


- To conduct activities from time to time, as prescribed relating to their respective club.

- To ensure events in college are conducted smoothly.


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
NEW HORIZON STUDENT CLUBS
