


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Student Feedback Analysis


Q1- Library Facilities



Out of around 1301 responses collected from the students, the committee analysed the results and following are the findings:


Out of 25 different classes and subsections, 96% have given the average rating of above 4 on a scale of 5 to the library facility which means only 4 % students have given the average rating of 3.96. To cover this gap, the areas of improvement recommended by the committee is to add more physical and e-books from different authors to give better perspective on the different subjects to the students.

Q2- Placement Support Provided



Out of 25 different classes and subsections, 96% have given the average rating of above 3.5 on a scale of 5 to the Placement support provided which means only 4 % students have given the average rating of 2.96. 24% have given the average rating of above 4 on scale of 5. This data of placement support feedback belongs to the duration when Covid has caused a major economic shock to the corporate sector. The areas of improvements were discussed and committee recommended including more value-added programs to make our students 'job-ready'.

Q-3 Canteen Facilities




Out of 25 different classes and subsections, 92% have given the average rating of above 3.7 on a scale of 5 to the Canteen Facilities provided which means only 8% students have given the average rating of 3.6 on a scale of 5.

40% have given the average rating of above 4 on scale of 5.



Q-4 Lab Facilities




Out of 25 different classes and subsections, 88% have given the average rating of above 3.5 on a scale of 5 to the Lab Facilities whereas 64% have given the average rating of above 3.7 on scale of 5. The areas of improvements were discussed and committee recommended to update the software in the computer labs.

Q5 Cyber LAB



Out of 25 different classes and subsections, 88% have given the average rating of above 3.5 on a scale of 5 to the Cyber Lab Facilities whereas 52% have given the rating of 3.7 on a scale of 5. The areas of improvements were discussed and committee suggested that the latest and robust anti-virus software's and various privacy features should be installed.


Q6 Class Infrastructure


Q7) Extra- Curricular Activities at college


Q8) Responsiveness of college administrative office


College admin office plays a key role in running the institute successfully. Therefore, the areas of improvements were discussed and recommendations of the committee were duly implemented.


Q10) Responsiveness of Accounts office



Out of 25 different classes and subsections, 84% have given the average rating of above 3.5 on a scale of 5 to extra-curricular activities at college whereas 68% have given the average rating of above 3.7 on scale of 5.

Q11) Transport Facilities



Out of 25 different classes and subsections, 96% have given the average rating of above 3.5 on a scale of 5 to extra-curricular activities at college whereas 44% have given the average rating of above 3.7 on scale of 5.


Q12) Toilet Facilities and Maintenance
