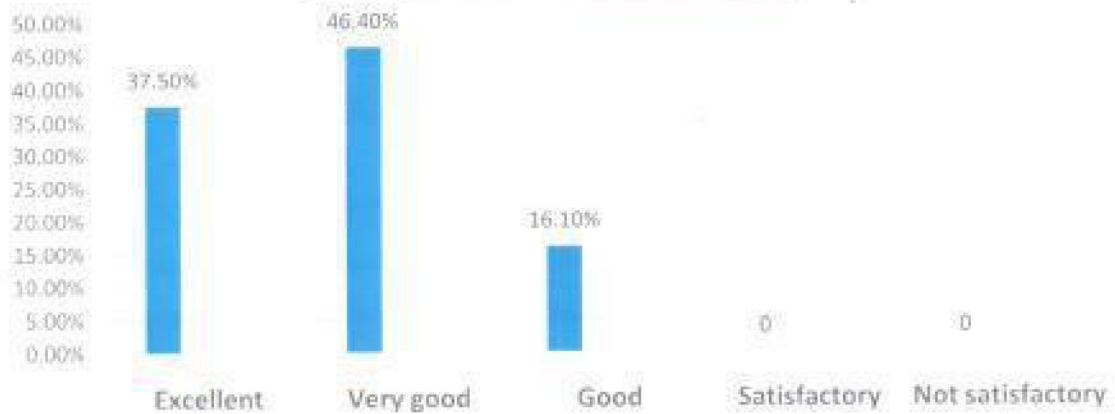

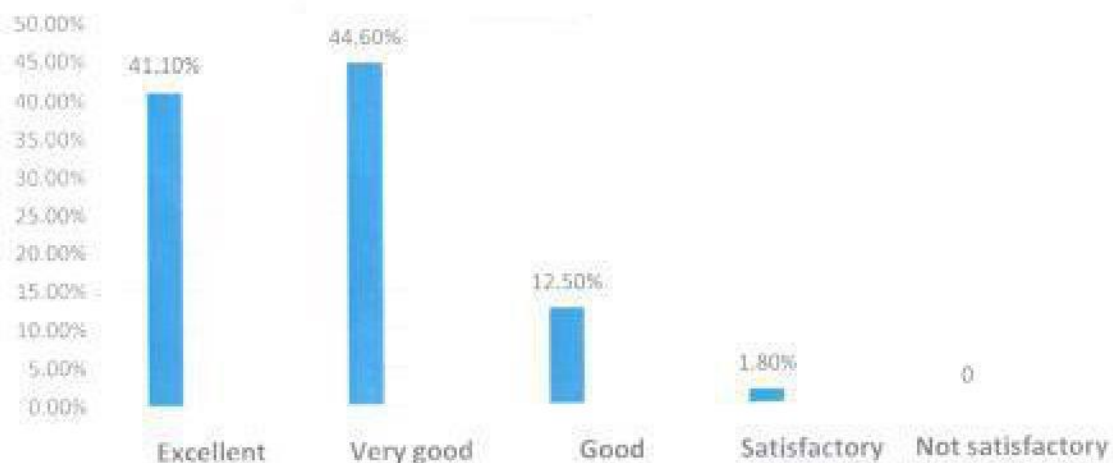

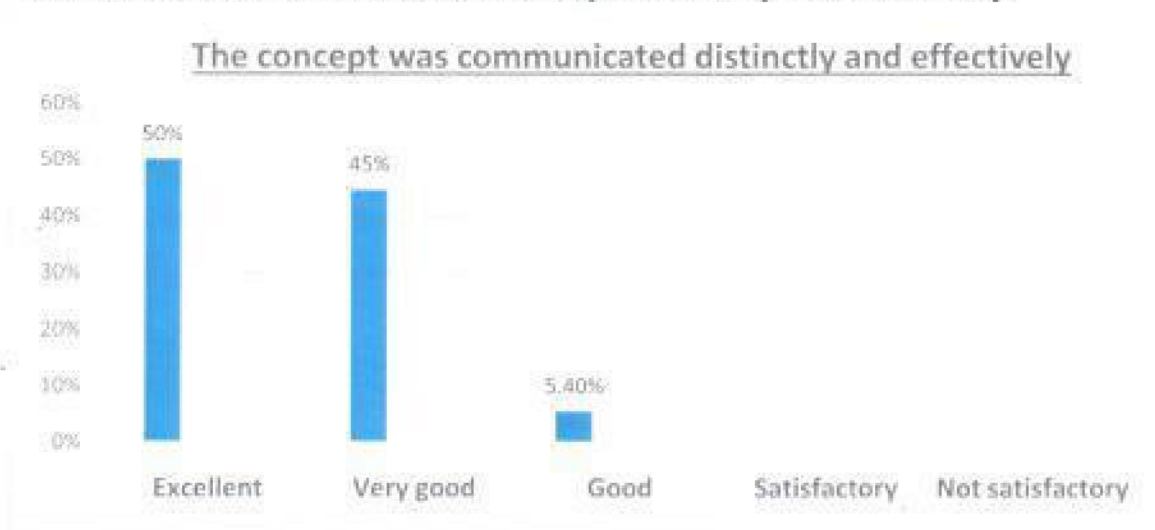


III) **The concept was explained with examples:** The number of respondents is 56 . The below mentioned graph indicate the total respondents' feedback on ease of understanding with examples.

The concept was explained with examples



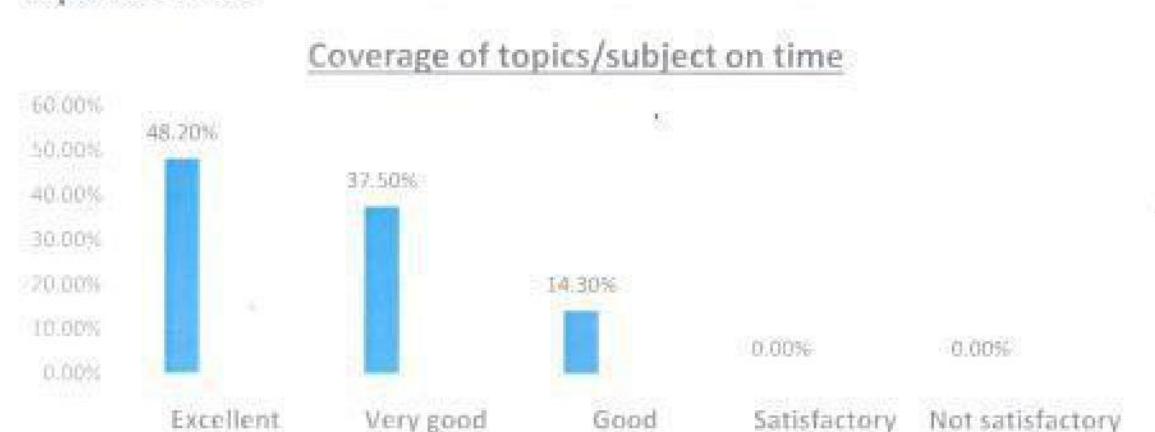

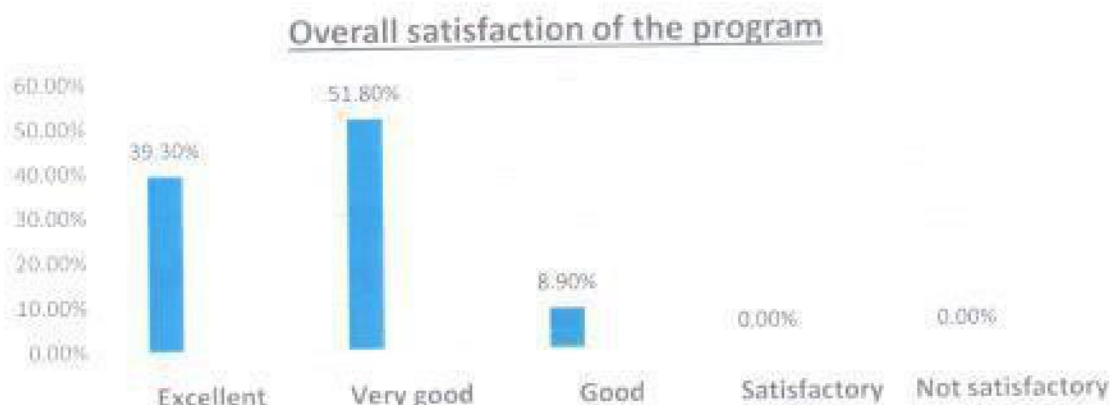
- V) **Quality of study materials:** The number of respondents is 56 .The below mentioned graph indicate the total respondents' feedback on quality of study materials.

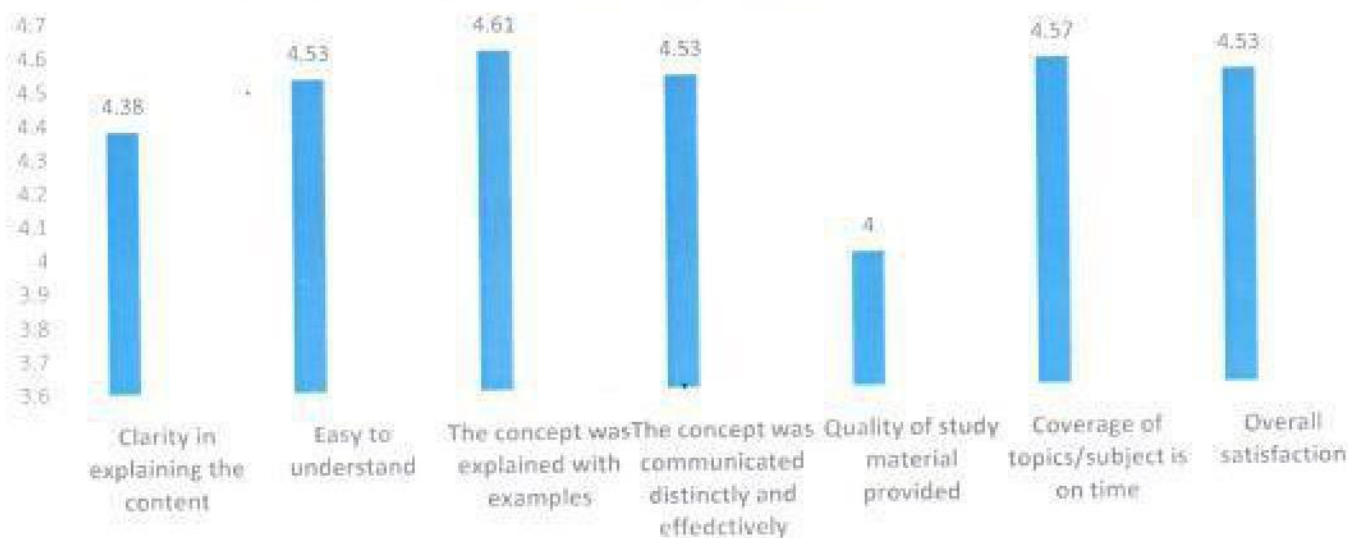
VII) **Overall satisfaction of the program** : The number of respondents is 56. The below mentioned graph indicate the total respondents' feedback on overall satisfaction of the program.
