






II) <u>Easy to understand</u>: The number of respondents is 56. The below mentioned graph indicate the total respondents' feedback on ease of understanding.



III) The concept was explained with examples: The number of respondents is 56. The below mentioned graph indicate the total respondents' feedback on ease of understanding with examples.






