Additionally, the NHRC is proactive in protecting the rights of children, elderly persons, and individuals with mental health conditions. It also monitors issues such as access to healthcare, education, and social security. The session emphasized the commission's role as a quasi-judicial body with the power to summon individuals, review complaints, and recommend action against human rights violations. Participants gained valuable insights into how complaints can be filed and the importance of awareness in upholding human rights.
