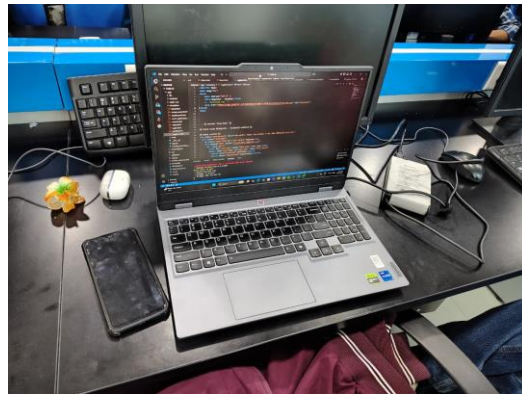
As the day progressed, projects began taking tangible shape. Teams integrated various components, tested functionalities, and refined their implementations. The collaborative
