The Objectives of the Programme

The Objectives of the Programme

- To familiarise students with the library layout and available facilities. To explain the library login process and borrowing procedures.
- To create awareness about the physical and digital resources available in the library. To train students in using the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC).
- To encourage effective utilisation of library resources for academic and research purposes.

The second session of the induction programme was a Library Orientation Programme conducted for the first-semester BCA, BBA, and B.Com students. The objective of the session was to familiarise students with the college library, its facilities, resources, and the procedures for accessing both physical and digital learning materials.

The session began with an introduction to the layout of the library, where students were informed about the different sections, including the reference section, textbook section, periodicals, newspapers, journals, and digital resources. They were guided on how books are systematically arranged and how to locate the required resources efficiently.

Students were then introduced to the library login process and were shown how to access their individual library accounts. The resource person explained the procedures for borrowing and returning books, checking due dates, and following the library rules and regulations.

The session also highlighted the wide range of resources available in the library, including academic textbooks, reference books, competitive examination materials, journals, magazines, newspapers, e-books, and online databases. Students were encouraged to make regular use of these resources to enhance their academic learning and research skills.

A demonstration on the use of the Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) was conducted, where students learned how to search for books by title, author, subject, or keyword. They were shown how to check the availability and location of books within the library using the OPAC system, enabling them to access resources quickly and independently.

The orientation concluded with an interactive session where students clarified their doubts regarding library membership, borrowing procedures, OPAC usage, and digital resources. Overall, the programme equipped students with the knowledge and confidence to effectively utilise the library facilities throughout their academic journey.

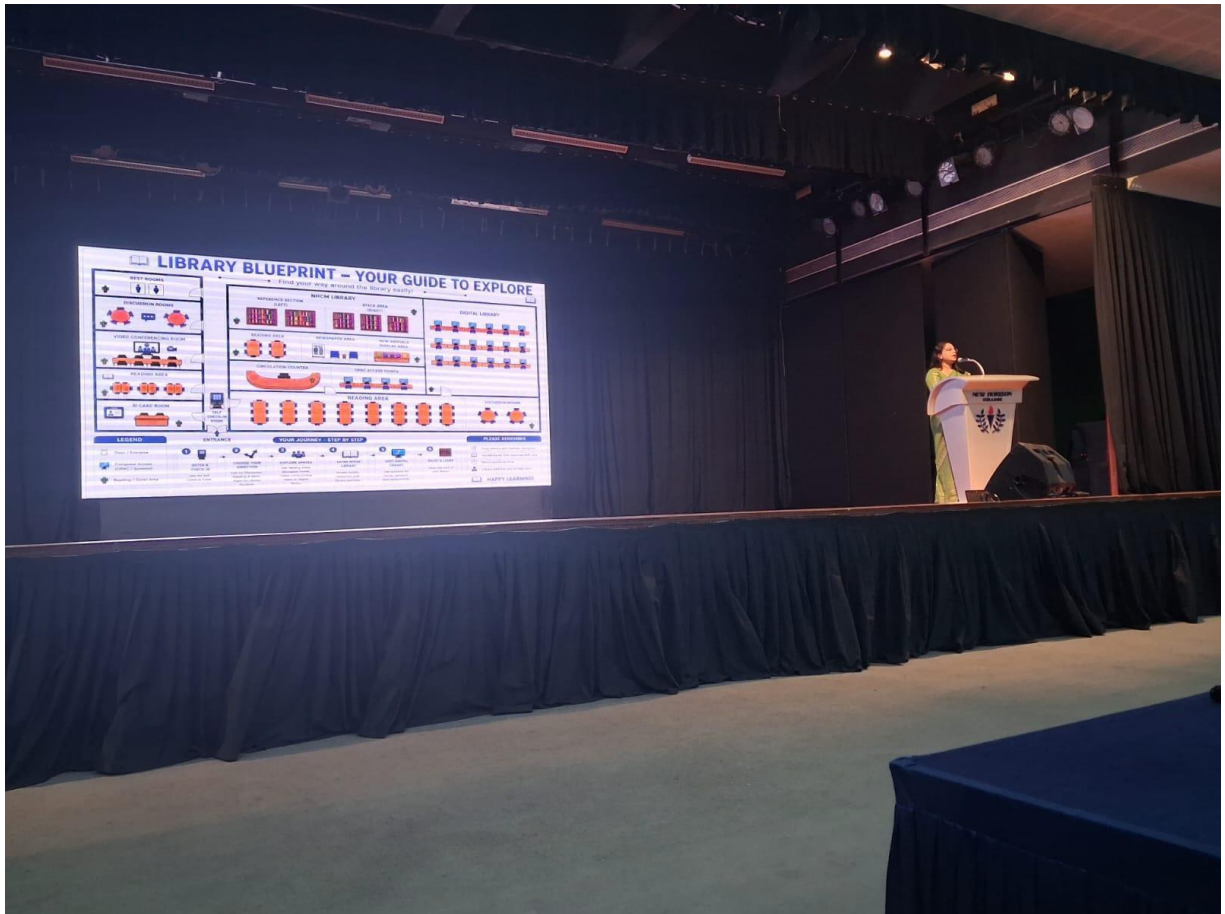
Outcomes of the Session
