The objective of the Programme

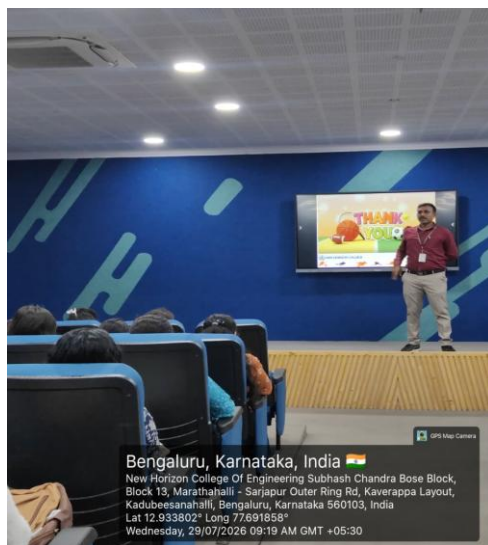
- Welcoming the students to the culture of New Horizon College

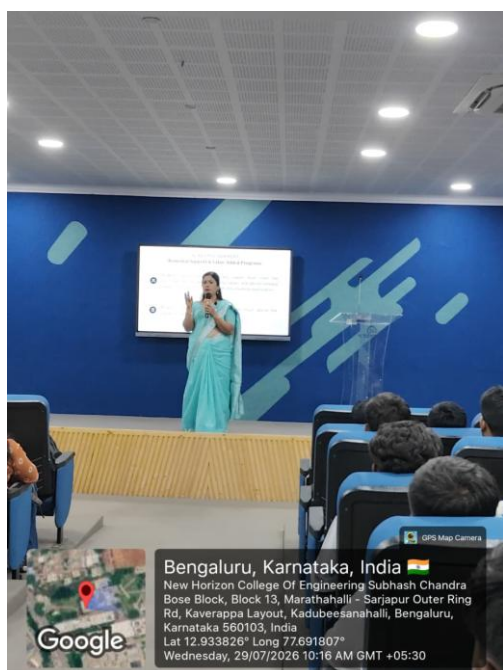
